Powers Pond in the Fall

The rain had slowed down to a steady drizzle and there was still not even the slightest breeze. Just as I remembered from the weekend before, at the club outing, weed growth was within a foot of the ponds surface. At first thought one might be wishing that there was not all this weed growth, however if the weeds were absent I also realized that most of the trout would have no longer been in Powers Pond. Over all I would have to say the stars looked to be perfectly aligned for my days fishing.

While putting on my flippers I could not help but notice trout breaking the water's surface even though the drizzle had reverted back to rain. Out of instinct I quickly reached for my fly rod and dropped my fly into the closest dimple. When the fly hit the water my fly line took off across the pond. It was a simple matter of grabbing the fly line to set the hook on the trout. The 15 inch trout was soon brought to hand however when I tried to set it on my stripping apron, I felt the Rainbow wrapping around my leg. Looking down I discovered that in my hurry to take advantage of the rising trout, I had failed to attach my stripping basket. It gave me a good laugh at myself and was to be the only major glitch to my days fishing. I finally got hold of the trout so I could release it and unwound the fly line from my leg.

For the next two hours the fishing was as simple as watching for rising trout, then putting my fly in the vicinity. Most of the trout ran in the 14 to 15 inch range with a few eight inchers and one monster well over twenty inches. I found it interesting that some of the trout from the spring planting were still in Powers Pond. But then again who but me would want to fish in such a weed infested mess!




